'Andrea Palladio and Palladianism: Four centuries of a style' - A talk by Charles Hind

Charles is an architectural historian and both Chief Curator and H J Heinz Curator of Drawings at the Royal Institute of British Architects.

He is also a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries, a Visiting Fellow at the Centro Palladio in Vicenza, Deputy Chairman of the Lutyens Trust and a Founder Trustee of the Great Dixter Trust.

Charles will describe how Palladio's buildings in Vicenza, and later Venice, and via Britain's colonial, commercial and political connections, have spread Palladianism around the globe.

Palladio's enormous archive of drawings, the largest autograph collection for any Italian Renaissance architect, has had an immense influence on British architecture since the early 17th century.

Palladianism is still an important influence on architecture today.
